Newman Mall / Amphitheater / Engineering Quad areas are central-campus gathering / academic spaces.

Main Building, East Hall, Student Union are adjacent, hosting administrative offices, studios, classrooms.

The campus sits amid an urban environment but feels more like a park within the city, offering a quieter enclave yet easy access to NYC's cultural life.

Public transit access is good: the Clinton-Washington Avenue station (G train) is nearby and often used by Pratt students.

Transportation & Airports

From Grand Central Station: Take 4 or 5 train downtown to Fulton Street → then A or C to Hoyt-Schermerhorn → cross platform to G (front car) → get off at Clinton-Washington to reach Pratt's campus.

From Penn Station: Take A or C to Hoyt-Schermerhorn → then G to Clinton-Washington → walk to campus.

Driving: Routes via BQE exits are described in Pratt's directions page.

Airports: While not explicitly detailed on Pratt's site, the major airports in the NYC area are JFK, LaGuardia, and Newark. The campus is reasonably reachable by taxi / shuttle + public transit.

Campus shuttle: Pratt maintains a shuttle schedule Monday–Friday which helps connect parts of campus / local transit spots.
