#### **Local Excursions:**

Exploration & Task: This is focused specifically around the town centre and would allow the students some freedom, with the teacher(s) in the vicinity. Sudents are issued with a map of Chelmsford centre and an 'Exploration Task' sheet. They should then go to each point on the map provided and try to match the place with the corresponding paragraph in the task sheet.

This is a reading task which encourages them to orientate themselves with the site and read and match the descriptions to what they can see. This is also complemented by class-time preparation to help with vocabulary etc where necessary. It can be made more fun/competitive by putting a time limit on it and giving prizes to the fastest/most correct answers, a bit like a 'scavenger hunt'.

#### Local extra activities:

The group can have lunch in the park on weekends and we can organise activities/games (depending on the time of the year so that is it not too cold). Students are able to use the center sports facilities subject to availability at the actual dates. Optional is visit to Spiceball Centre (swimming pool at extra cost) - extra may costs apply - see ADD ON for more information.

## Suggestions for local visits:

Walking Tour will cover the following places: Travel cards can be purchased on location. The tour will be guided by our Plus teacher. The students will receive the 'Before Tour' and 'After Tour' questions which are designed to encourage the students to engage with the site and reflect on it. The stduents also have access to the PLUS Audio Guide, honing their listening skills as well as educating them about the City or Twon history and quirks!

Other Dublin options are The Garden of Remembrance, Dublin City Gallery The Hugh Lane and Henry Streetg.
