Dublin - Ireland

Accommodation: Halls of Residence at Gormanston Park college.

Address – Gormanston, Co. Meath, Ireland, K32 NH30

- Halls of Residence over 4 Floors.
- Single and twin rooms available. Both standard and ensuite rooms available
- Towels provided
- Bed linen provided
- Irons and ironing boards available on request
- Common rooms available to students and group leaders in each hall of residence
- TV room available to students and group leaders in each hall of residence, including DVD player
- Kitchenette/cooking facilities not provided (full board so breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided by the college)
- Free WiFi provided in bedrooms.

The halls of residence are supervised by a housemistress/ housemaster

Max Capacity: 360

Catering: Able to cater for students with special dietary requirements (allergies or other particular needs). The dining hall is on the campus and seats 350.

Access: Keycards provided for students.

Damages: £5 charged for lost or damaged key.

Type of Furniture: Storage cage or Wardrobe available. Desk/table and chair available on Floor 3 (Hall C)

Laundry: Facilities available outside campus, Pick-up service approximately 8km from campus

Cleaning: Bedrooms, toilets, bathrooms & showers cleaned by staff every 2nd day. Common areas cleaned daily.

First Aid: First aiders on campus

Disabled Access: available – wheelchair access, lifts and room accessibility – disabled bathrooms including shower, toilet and wash facilities



Classrooms, computer facilities & internet:

10 classrooms available for PLUS on campus. LCD TVs, projectors & Whiteboards available in classrooms. Free WiFi provided.

Sports available on campus: Basketball, football, rugby, 5 a side. The sports hall is the largest sports complex in Ireland.

Other facilities:

- disco room available at Assembly Hall, situated opposite accommodation
- sports halls available for leisure & cultural activities also

Nearest hospital & medical centre:

Medical centre – onsite. (*Note:* health services offered free of charge ONLY if students has a European health card e1-11 – otherwise charged at £50)
