

DISCOVER LA ALPUJARRA

La Alpujarra is a beautiful mountain area on the southern side of the Sierra Nevada. It's famous for its white villages, narrow streets, fresh mountain air and amazing views of both the mountains and the Mediterranean Sea. The region still shows clear influences from Arab culture in its houses, terraces, food and irrigation systems.

Lanjaron



Lanjarón is often called the "town of water" thanks to its natural springs and historic spa. It sits on the hillside with white houses, small streets and viewpoints overlooking the valley and castle ruins. The town is also known for its clean air, long-living residents and its lively festival of San Juan, where locals celebrate with water fights and music.

Soportujar, land of witches



Soportujar is a small mountain village with a fun twist – it's themed around legends of witches and magic. Walking through the streets, you'll find sculptures of witches, dragons, enchanted bridges and fairy-tale houses inspired by stories like Baba Yaga and Hansel & Gretel. It's a great stop for unique photos and a bit of imagination.



Pampaneira



Pampaneira is one of the three famous villages in the Poqueira Valley. It's known for its beautiful whitewashed houses, flat rooftops and traditional chimneys. The village has small shops selling handmade ceramics, colourful rugs and local produce. You'll also find fountains with legendary stories – one of them promises that anyone who drinks the water will soon find love!
